

Give Fleece a Chance and the online Wool Directory. Linking wool producers to wool users, one fleece at a time.

This installation was created and developed by Cornish-based textile designer Claire Crompton with the help of UK-based wool producers and knitters and spinners. It is comprised entirely of British wool, displaying the myriad variety and qualities of wool produced as well as the interest and demand of users – knitters, spinners, artists, makers – for this highly sustainable yet undervalued resource.

It also forms the research for a new, **free**, web-based **Wool Directory** initiated by the Centre for Contemporary Art and the Natural World (CCANW) to link up producers, users, and others in the supply chain, more easily:

Wool producers – market your fleece or yarn to potential buyers and connect with others in the wool supply chain.

Wool users – connect with producers, share information and promote your products.

Also an educational resource for the general public, the online Wool Directory is the latest in a series of projects, which, over the past two years, CCANW has initiated to raise the profile of wool and its contribution to the economy and local distinctiveness.
